- Annual Conference in Harrison May 3-5 LMLGA alone represents **two thirds** of BC's population.




# North Central (NCLGA)






- 32 Municipalities, many very small

- Conference Vernon April 25-27







## Kootenay Boundary (AKBLGA)


- 5 Regional Districts

- Conference Cranbrook April 21-23








Silverton, etc.



- 41 Municipalities
  - 10 Cities, 15 Districts, 8 Towns, 8 Villages
- 11 Regional Districts
  - 55 Electoral Area Directors (out of 159 in province)
- Islands Trust
  - 26 elected members

We are the largest Area Association by number of governments and elected officials






### **AVICC RDs by Population**

- Largest: Capital
  - Population: 415,451 (2021 census)
  - Directors: 24 (3 Rural)
  - Operating Budget: approx. \$500 million (\$1,200 per capita)
  - Area: 2,340 km<sup>2</sup>
  - Density: 163.8 km<sup>2</sup>


### Smallest: Central Coast

- Population: 3,582 (2021 census)
- Directors: 5 Rural
- Operating Budget: \$14 million (\$4,000 per capita)
- Area: 24,492 km<sup>2</sup>
- Density: 0.15/ km<sup>2</sup>








### Population: Rural vs Municipal




