





New Construction Compliance Pathway

CSA Z240MH

Even with wheels it's possible to meet Code or CSA requirements

Foundation Stability

Per BCBC Code Standards, CSA Z240MH, or securing methods designed by structural engineer.

Servicing and Water

As with any dwelling/ADU, THOWs should meet health and safety standards for water, septic and electrical.




